PLEASE NOTE: if at the time of entry closing, any group is larger than expected - the above schedule for judging may be altered to make more efficient use of the time allotted.

Special Show Awards - Breed

Trophies will be presented at the Awards Dinner on the Sunday.

The Best Visitor award: a trophy will be awarded to the best visitor's dog in the four shows.

The Bermuda Kennel Club award: a trophy will be awarded to the dog owned or co-owned by a Bermuda resident who acquires the highest accumulated points over the four shows.

Best Puppy award: a trophy will be awarded to the best puppy in the four shows.

Best Bermuda Bred award: a trophy will be awarded to the best Bermuda bred dog in the four shows.

Best Locally Owned award: a trophy will be awarded to the best locally owned dog in the four shows.

Best Veteran award: a trophy will be awarded to the best veteran in the four shows.

Best Owner Handled award: a trophy will be awarded to the best owner handled dog in the four shows.

If an exhibitor wins a Show Award they must arrange for the collection of such award at the Awards Dinner. The Club will not be responsible for delivery.



Scale of Points for Special Show Awards Only

Best in Show: 5 points, Reserve Best in Show: 5 points, Group 1st: 4 points*, Group 2nd: 3 points*, Group 3rd: 2 points*, Group 4th: 1 point*
 * The number of points at group level will depend on the number of breeds defeated: Group First – 4 points (if 4 or more breeds are present in the Group judging), 3 points (if only 3 breeds are present), 2 points (if only 2 breeds are present) and 1 point (if only one breed is present). In the event of a tie; the decision will be based on the amount of dogs defeated.

This scale of points is used to determine the recipients of Special Show Awards which are presented at the dinner after the shows ONLY. It should not be confused with the Bermuda Championship Schedule of Points (see below).

Unofficial Classes

The calculations for the Best Bermuda Bred, Best Puppy, Best Locally Owned, Best Veteran and Best Owner Handled are based on the total number of wins in these respective classes. In the event of a tie, the decision will be based on the amount of dogs defeated. Only dogs entered in these respective classes are eligible for the Awards.

Breed Trophy List

Ribbons, first through fourth will be awarded each show, in each breed.

A rosette will be awarded each show to first in Group and a rosette to second, third and fourth in Group. Also, a rosette will be awarded to Best Bermuda Bred, Best Puppy, Best Locally Owned, Best Veteran, and Best Owner Handled in each Group.

A rosette will be awarded each show for Best In Show, Reserve Best in Show, Best Bermuda Bred in Show, Best Puppy in Show, Best Locally Owned Dog in Show, Best Veteran in Show and Best Owner Handled in Show.

Ribbons will also be awarded each show in all categories noted in BKC rules, Ch. 5, Sec. 1 as they apply.

BERMUDA CHAMPIONSHIP - SCHEDULE OF POINTS

BERMUDA CHAMPIONSHIP TITLES:

The points required for the award of a Bermuda Championship may be accumulated from one show to another. Any dog placing first, second, third or fourth in the Group shall be awarded the highest number of points for any dog of any Breed it defeats in that Group, or its own points, whichever is higher. These points shall not be in addition to but inclusive of, the points previously won in the Breed. The Best Dog in Show shall be awarded 5 championship points, inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level. The Reserve Best Dog in Show shall be awarded 4 championship points, inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

Points are based on the number of dogs present

Only dogs entered in the Official Classes will be counted as being present for the purpose of Championship ratings but additional points in accordance with the points scale will be awarded for any Champions of Record subsequently defeated directly or indirectly in Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex Competition. In computing the Championship Points for a Breed Class, a dog that is disqualified or excused during judging shall not be counted as being present at the Show. BKC Rules Ch. 7, Sec. 2

Breed Classification (OFFICIAL Classes)

Dogs may be entered in any of the following classes for which they are eligible:

- Puppy Class 6 - 9 months:** Champions in any country excluded
- Puppy Class 9 - 12 months:** Champions in any country excluded
- Puppy Class 12 - 18 months:** Champions in any country excluded
To be eligible for Best Puppy Awards, puppies must be entered in the Puppy Classes. Puppies entered in the Junior & Senior Puppy Classes must be within the age limit on the day of the Show.
- Novice Class:** for dogs which have not, prior to the date of closing of entries, been awarded one or more points toward their Bermuda Championship title. Champions in any country excluded.
- Bred by Exhibitor Class:** for dogs owned wholly or in part and handled in the ring, by the person or the spouse of the person who was the Breeder or one of the Breeders of Record. Champions in any country excluded.
- Open Class:** for dogs whose owners have not been notified officially by the Bermuda Kennel Club that the dog has earned the required number of points, under the conditions prescribed in Ch. 7, Sec. 1, For the award of a Bermuda Championship. Champions of record in any other country must be entered in this class.
- Best of Breed Competition:** Bermuda Champions of record only shall be entered in this competition. Bermuda Champions that are over 7 years old and have been spayed or neutered may be entered in Best of Breed Competition.

Note: BKC Rules Ch. 11, Sec. 10. Where, according to the records of its owner or handler, a dog entered in a Show or a series of Shows has completed the Points Requirements for its Championship after the closing of entries, but this has not yet been confirmed by the Bermuda Kennel Club, the dog may, upon request to the Show Superintendent, be transferred from the Official Classes entered, to Best of Breed competition provided it is registered with the Bermuda Kennel Club. Such request must be made on a transfer of entry form provided by the Bermuda Kennel Club, and must be filed with the Show Superintendent not less than one half hour prior to the start of all judging at the subsequent Show(s) of the series. Should the owner or handler be mistaken in computing the dog's points and the dog compete in Best of Breed competition before it actually has the required points, any wins at that show(s) will be automatically canceled. No dog may otherwise be transferred to another class.



Breed - UNOFFICIAL Classes

1. **Bermuda Bred Class:** for dogs born in Bermuda. To be eligible for Best Bermuda Bred Awards dogs must be entered in the Bermuda Bred Class and also an Official Class.
2. **Locally Owned Class:** for dogs that are not Bermuda Bred, but are owned wholly or in part by a permanent resident of Bermuda. To be eligible for Best Locally Owned Awards dogs must be entered in the Locally Owned Class and must also be entered in an Official Class.
3. **Veteran Class:** for dogs that are 7 years old or older on the day of the Show. To be eligible for Best Veteran Awards dogs must be entered in the Veteran Class. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.
4. **Owner Handled Class:** shall be for dogs that are owned wholly or in part by the exhibitor, excluding professional handlers: their household members, and their assistants.
5. **Exhibition Only:** for dogs not entered in an Official or Unofficial Breed Class or Junior Showmanship.

Junior Showmanship Competition

1. **NOVICE:** for juniors who are at least 7 years old and under 17 on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won 3 first place awards in a novice junior showmanship class at shows held under BKC rules in competition with one or more junior handlers.
2. **OPEN:** for juniors who are least 7 years old and under 17 on the day of the Show and who have won at least 3 first place awards in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at Shows held under the BKC Rules. The winner of the Novice Class automatically becomes eligible to enter and compete in the Open Class at the same Show provided, that the win is his third first place award in Novice and that there are one or more additional Junior Handlers in the Open Class.

Non-purebred dogs may now be entered in Junior Showmanship provided that they are registered in the BKC Mixed Breed Register before the shows. Application Forms for the Mixed Breed Register can be obtained from Registration Officer at bkc@northrock.bm or <http://www.show.bkc.bm/forms.html>

If, after the close of entries, a Junior Handler wishes to substitute another otherwise eligible dog in the Junior Showmanship Class for which he/she is entered the Junior Handler may do so provided he/she supplies the Superintendent or Show Secretary with the required identifying information on the dog at least one half hour prior to the start of judging of the class in which the Junior Handler is to compete. The substitute dog must be entered in one of the Breed or Obedience Classes or any other Junior Showmanship Class at the Show and the Junior Handler must wear an armband with the substitute dog's catalogue number.

Junior Showmanship Trophy List

Rosettes will be awarded each day for the best novice junior handler and the best open junior handler in each class. A rosette will also be awarded to the best overall junior handler. A trophy will be awarded to the best overall junior handler for the two shows who is resident in Bermuda, to be presented at the Awards Dinner on Sunday.

General Information

1. **COMPETITION AT THE GROUP LEVEL** in classes that do not carry championship points is optional, i.e. Best Puppy, Best Bermuda Bred, Best Locally Owned, Best Veteran and Best Owner Handled.
Points earned at Breed Level will not be forfeited if the dog does not compete in these Classes. (BKC Rules Ch. 7, Sec. 10). Dogs may be removed from the grounds as soon as they have been judged, unless required for further judging.
2. **THE SHOW COMMITTEE** reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to BKC rules.
3. **ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF ENTRY** will be sent by e-mail upon receipt of correct entry.
4. **CRATES & GROOMING TABLES** will only be permitted in the allocated areas.
5. **JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT** for any dog holding up a class. Owners or handlers alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the ring when their classes are called to be judged.
6. **THE SUPERINTENDENT WILL BE IN COMPLETELY IN CHARGE OF THE SHOWS.**
7. **NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS: all dogs need to be up-to-date on all vaccinations.**
8. Each registered participant will receive one (1) free catalogue. Any additional Catalogues will need to be purchased.
9. **OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR** errors in filling out Entry Forms, no matter who may make such errors. **Dogs & owners names MUST be exactly as the Registration Certificate.** If any part of the required information or signature is not furnished, such failure may mean the cancellation of any awards or prizes won at that show by the dog not properly entered as required by the Bermuda Kennel Club rules.
10. **NO ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED** if the Shows cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, strikes, hurricanes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Show Superintendent.
11. **JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP** will be held directly after completion of BIS classes, there will be a 30 minute break at the completion of JR Showmanship before the second show starts. This is subject to change if the number of JRs entries is greater than 10.
12. **CRUFTS 2018** These shows have been nominated as Qualifying shows for Crufts 2018. The qualifying dogs for each of the four shows will be the winners of the following: All Group Winners, Best Puppy in Show, and Best Veteran in Show.



Attention Overseas Exhibitors

Transport & Accommodation

Arrangements may be made through your travel agent, or by contacting the airline and hotel or guest house of your choice. You can see dog friendly lodgings on our website at http://bermudakennelclub.com/contact_us.html. Make your airline reservations early and mention the number of dogs you will be bringing and approximate crate sizes & weight. Also be sure that you have confirmation from the airline. **Some airlines have special rates coming to Bermuda ...so please enquire.**

Overseas Entries will NOT be Accepted Unless Accompanied by the Appropriate Rabies Certificates
Dogs arriving from the U.S. or Canada MAY NOT ENTER Bermuda UNDER THE AGE OF 10 MONTHS

Requirements for Bringing Dogs into Bermuda from the US and Canada

BERMUDA IMPORT PERMIT: *The Show Committee will obtain these permits as soon as each Entry Form and Rabies Vaccination Certificate are received and accepted. The Import Permit will be emailed to the email address shown on the entry form. Please read carefully, the requirements for bringing dogs into Bermuda which will be on the Import Permit and reads as below:*

Importer must be able to present certificate(s) from a licensed veterinarian identifying each dog by reference to its name, breed, sex, age and colour, and which accurately document compliance with the following conditions:

MICROCHIP: The animal has been implanted with a microchip read by a standard microchip reader, i.e. ISO, FECAVA, European/International or AVID-USA chip.

HEALTH CERTIFICATE: A veterinary health certificate issued within 10 days before your arrival in Bermuda, stating that each animal is not infected with any communicable disease and is free of external parasites.

PEST CONTROL: A veterinary statement that each animal has been treated on the day of examination with an acaricidal preparation (named), which is known to have residual activity against ticks, e.g. flea and tick spray, powder, dip, or FrontLine Top Spot®, Ovitrol®, Ssectrol®, K9 Advantix®, Proticall®, Kiltix®, Defend Ex-Spot®, Promeris® for Dogs.

NOTE: *Advantage®, Sentinel®, Revolution®, selamectin, Capstar®, Bio-Spot®, Promeris® for Cats, Vectra 3D®, Comfortis®, shampoos and collars do not qualify.*

RABIES VACCINATION CERTIFICATE: A veterinary statement that, as best as can be ascertained by your veterinarian's knowledge and through questioning, each animal has not been exposed to rabies nor been present in an officially quarantined rabies area within the last 6 months.

A Rabies vaccination history, showing at least two rabies vaccinations, and that all rabies vaccinations have been given by a licensed veterinarian, and are in accord with all of these requirements. Each animal :

- Upon attaining / after the age of three months, has received a rabies vaccination; **and**
- Received a second rabies vaccine 6-12 months following the first rabies vaccination; **and**
- There have been no significant lapses in vaccinations; **and**
- The most recent vaccination was given at least 30 days prior to arrival in Bermuda;

Dogs under age 10 months, and dogs of any age that have received only a single rabies vaccination, do not qualify for entry into Bermuda.

This Import Permit together with all certificates indicating the date issued, must accompany the dog(s) at the time of arrival in Bermuda.

Dogs arriving directly from the U.K., Ireland, Australia, New Zealand or Jamaica do not need a Rabies vaccination.

All other conditions of entry as outlined by the Department remain in effect.

If you are in any doubt about whether or not your dog has the required vaccinations, please fax a copy of your dog's complete vaccination history to the Department of Environmental Protection, Animal Husbandry 441 236-7582, Animal Imports 441 232-0046 or email: animals@gov.bm

CLEARING CUSTOMS: dogs arriving in Bermuda for the Shows are exempt from Customs Duty. We suggest you bring documentation of vaccination records, which may be needed for customs clearance.

Requirements for Re-Entry into the United States

CERTIFICATE OF VACCINATION AGAINST RABIES, as described on your import permit. Although the Rabies Vaccination Certificate will have already been submitted with the entry form, it would be wise to include a copy of the certificate with your travel documents

HEALTH CERTIFICATE, signed by a Veterinarian **not more than ten days prior to your re-entry to the U.S.**

Requirements for Re-Entry into Canada

Certificate from a Bermuda Veterinarian certifying that Bermuda is free from rabies and that your dog has been inspected and found free from any symptoms of contagious disease.

Exhibitors will be notified of the time when the show veterinarian will be on the show grounds for the purpose of issuing health certificates. There is no charge for this service.

Please note 4 NEW additions to the Bermuda Dog Shows under BKC Rules

- 1.) **NEW BKC rule: ALL dogs must be registered within 90 days of their first competition** to be eligible to retain/keep awards and championship points. See Chapter 11, Section 2
- 2.) There is a new unofficial class - **Owner Handled** – See Chapter 4, Section 4: **BEST OWNER-HANDLED** shall be for dogs that are owned wholly or in part by the exhibitor, excluding professional handlers, their household members, and their handler assistants.
- 3.) **NEW CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS FOR BIS & RBIS** – See Chapter 7, Section 2: A dog awarded Winners which also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with 5 championship points, inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level. A dog awarded Winners which also places Reserve Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with 4 championship points, inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.
- 4.) Bermuda has added the title of Grand Champion to its lineup. **Please review the BKC Rules Chapter 7 Champions, Grand Champions and Championship Points, Section 1(b)**
In order to become a Grand Champion competing dogs **MUST** first have completed the necessary points and requirements to be deemed a Bermuda Champion of Record. Once they have achieved the title of Champion they can then compete to earn points towards their Grand Championship. The point scale is the same, however dogs must then be awarded at least twenty championship points, including one Best of Breed win and a minimum of 2 wins of at least 2-points (or better). Only when all these requirements have been met may a dog be recognized as a Bermuda Grand Champion and its owner at the time the dog completes its grand championship be provided with a Grand Championship Certificate.
