1. This completed form should be returned to the Bermuda Kennel Club together with the fee and a copy of the proposed Constitution and By-Laws which should include:
 - a. What the club/society will consist of: specify President/Chairman, Vice-President, Treasurer, Secretary, Directors etc.
 - b. List of said Officers/Directors, their email address, contact information and signatures
2. Members of the club/society shall be deemed to have agreed to the authority of the Bermuda Kennel Club and its Board of Governors.
3. The club agrees to follow the Rules & Regulations of the Bermuda Kennel Club.
4. The Bermuda Kennel Club is the final authority for interpreting the rules of the club/society in all cases relative to canine or society matters.
5. Any member who shall be disqualified under BKC Rules shall ipso facto cease to be a member of the club/society.
6. A club/society must not make arrangements to hold Shows, Trials or Tests until the BKC has agreed to register the new club/society.
7. Registered Judges and show/trial dates must be submitted to the Bermuda Kennel Club for approval before any advertising or promotion.



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8. The BKC will only approve one national club for each breed. All-breed clubs will welcome pure-bred dog owners of every breed registered by the BKC. Group clubs are open to owners of all breeds from one of the seven Groups. Obedience, Agility & Tracking Clubs are open to all breeds plus mixed breeds and Infinite Listing Priviledge (ILP).
9. The aforementioned procedures shall also apply in the case of an application to re-register a Club/Society following a period of cessation of registration.
10. Once this form and the other necessary documents are returned to the BKC the Board will consider the application, if provisionally accepted, will advertised on the BKC website and to BKC Members. If, after being advertised and reconsidered by the Board, together any objections which may have been received, the Board approves the application, the new Club/Society will be added to the BKC Register.
